PARENT SCHOOL VISITATION POLICY

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is for parent awareness as to school visits.

Policy: The Grande Innovation Academy appreciates the value of parent and school partnership in ensuring a student's success, so we encourage our parents to be a part of our school and meet with teachers. Parents/guardians can visit the classroom (including the playground) at the teacher and/or school's invitation. If you wish to visit or give a classroom presentation, please be sure to make an appointment with the classroom teacher several days in advance. Siblings are not allowed to attend.

In order to protect the privacy of other students and maintain a proper learning environment, parents/guardians may not film, tape, or record school activities during the observation and/or visitation and must turn off mobile phones. The Executive Director and office staff have the authority to deny access to the school for any individual who has been disruptive or may disrupt or disturb the learning environment, or who lacks a valid or legal purpose for entering the school.

Volunteers in the classroom are not allowed to assist their child with his/her work, grade any papers or access student information systems. Volunteers are not allowed on campus during benchmark or state testing.

Anyone entering the school for volunteering must present their ID and have it scanned. If there is no ID presented that person may not enter the campus. All volunteers must have completed one volunteer workshop before chaperoning or volunteering on campus.

Volunteers should be dressed appropriately: shorts with a minimum 5-inch inseam, skirts/dresses to the knee, no cleavage showing, no spaghetti straps, cover any inappropriate tattoos, no holes in jeans, and modest jewelry.
